## **Introducing N.O.W.**

Hi, I'm Dick Gruber, Children's Pastor. In 1979 I began to serve in my first children's Pastorate at Christian Life Church in Farmington, Minnesota. After four years as a volunteer children's church leader, helper, evangelist, and go-for, I was now being paid to reach children.

I have always had a heart for reaching out to children. From the first time I rode on a Sunday school bus, I have had a growing desire to see more and more children won to the Lord, Jesus Christ. Shortly after beginning this first Children's Pastorate, my senior pastor asked me to make plans for the next calendar year. I wanted to host a kids crusade, but a one time event like that didn't seem to be enough. I began searching the calendar for a free days in the summer that could be dedicated to reaching children. With camps, conferences, holidays, and special church events, I finally narrowed my search to a single week in late July.

The challenge now was to figure out the best way to utilize that one week for the glory of God. Thus, Neighborhood Outreach Week was born. My dream was to reach as many children in as many neighborhoods as I could in one week.

That first year, my wife and three or four lay volunteers joined me as we reached almost one hundred children in five neighborhoods. I was in a small church and one hundred kids reached was a fabulous victory. The following year, over seventy-five people from my church became involved, reaching close to four hundred children in fifteen neighborhoods. The following spring, I moved to Oregon. I tried the idea in my new church, but N.O.W. never caught on like it did in Minnesota.

at the writing of this, I find myself in another church where our most recent N.O.W. reached just over 1,100 children and adults in 25 different neighborhoods covering nine different suburbs. We had five teams with over fifty people involved in them. Add that number to those hosting N.O.W. meetings and well over a hundred and twenty people from our church took part in this most recent outreach.

In 1998, a woman from our church suggested that we change the advertised name in neighborhoods. She felt that the term, "outreach," may have been a roadblock to some who needed to attend the meetings. As a result of her input, we came up with the concept of "Side Yard Parties."

What happens at a Side Yard Party? Clowns and costumed characters are sent out with normal young people to hand out flyers, literally pried piper children in to the N.O.W. Side Yard Party location. As children arrive in the front or side yard of a host home, games are played using jump ropes and large beach balls. Children are checked in at a registration table and given an opportunity to win a door prize. Children are seated on a fresh tarp or drop cloth laid on the lawn and the service begins. The party begins as clowns, puppets, stories, and songs are used in a forty minute Gospel service.

Each Side Yard Party service follows a specific theme and concludes with a salvation prayer and prize

give-a-way. Prizes are given away at each location so that children will be motivated to fill out a registration card. These cards are used in a drawing for the prize, then later serve as follow up cards.

The following material is broken into three categories. First there is a general section. This includes miscellaneous photocopy-able sheets that can be used with any N.O.W. program. Following this I have included three complete N.O.W. services.

Remember, all visuals, (such as words to songs, scriptures, or stories), should be enlarged, mounted on poster board and laminated. I have not printed words to songs because of copyright considerations, but have given you information so that you can order these for your N.O.W. side Yard Parties. You may want to consider changing parts of the program to better fit your community or immediate availability of materials.

So have fun as you reach children in your community right N.O.W.!

## **N.O.W. Team Leader**

Now that you are a N.O.W. "Side Yard Party" Team leader, what do you do? You are leading a group of young people into a neighborhood for a one time evangelistic blitz. The members of your team look to you for spiritual leadership and practical advice. You are their authority and as such provide security through your confident leadership. You are serving in a pastoral role. Live by the question, "what Would Jesus Do?"

### **Specific Guidelines:**

1. Be on time. Team leaders should arrive at the church at least fifteen minutes prior to the designated team arrival times. Your presence at the church when your team members arrive each morning/evening, will help the children's pastor keep his sanity.
2. Pray, read the Bible, live a Christian life. Your devotional walk with Jesus will be put to the test this week. Your team members, Side Yard Party host, and neighborhood children will learn more by how you live than by what you say. (Gal 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.)
3. Each day you will check to insure that your team has enough flyers, follow-up material, registration cards, and a grand prize.
4. Count the number of team members who leave the church on your van. It is a good idea to recount upon leaving the host home to return to church. These numbers should match.
5. A magnetic sign is provided for each team. Place it on the side or back of your van when you arrive at the host home. You MUST take it off the van before leaving the host home. These signs stay on the vans well when the vans are not in motion. These signs should be laid flat while not in use.
6. When your complete team has entered the van at the church, say a prayer of protection and guidance with them. We will have already prayed earlier with the entire group, but a short prayer with your team will calm them, setting the tone for your entire morning/evening.
7. Encourage your team members. Proverbs16:21 The wise in heart are called discerning, and pleasant words promote instruction.
8. When arriving at the host home, your team should stay in the van until you have talked with the host family determining where to place the equipment. A family may want the set up in front, side, or back yard. Remind your team that they are not to enter the host home unless invited by the host, or when needing the bathroom.
9. Team leader makes all ministry assignments each day. Work with your team to produce the best possible results. Rotate the assignments as you can so that everyone gets some up front experience. Assignments should be clear in the minds of your workers prior to the beginning of the program.
10. After van is unloaded, send your team members out to distribute flyers, in groups of two or more. While they are out oversee the set up of your equipment.
11. At the conclusion of the program, oversee the loading of equipment back in the van. Some members can load equipment while others play with and talk to neighborhood children.
12. Keep the to the suggested schedule.
13. Have fun with your group.
14. Upon arrival back at the church, leave all equipment on the van, (except on Friday), Check to insure that your team members have rides home, and report your success to the children's pastor's secretary. (Judie)
15. Please hang with your team members until all have left the building.

## **Basic Guidelines For N.O.W. Team Members**

Never act or speak in a manner unbecoming of a believer in Christ. You represent Jesus and our church.

Obey the directives of your team leader. The last thing we need is arguing or conflict among team members in a host neighborhood. "To obey is better than sacrifice."

Worship God with your thoughts, speech, and life. Your faithfulness in this kind of ministry event will give you a depth of experience with, and greater understanding of God's love for the lost.

Never wear anything that would be considered inappropriate in a ministry setting. Comfortable, yet modest apparel will be worn by all N.O.W. members.

Overcome evil with good. Humble yourself before God and He will lift you up. No wrestling, punching, or rough play while serving on a N.O.W. team. Be kind one to another. Absolutely no practical joking is allowed on N.O.W. teams.

Walk with two or more members. There is safety and power in numbers. No team member is to walk alone. Clowns and costumed characters are to always be accompanied by their regular human counterpart. The human watches so that no child or adult blind-sides, hurts, or defaces the costume or clown.

Never treat a child with disrespect. We must talk with, and care for each child as if we were ministering to Jesus. A child may have a rotten attitude, but we must always reflect the love of Christ.

Ownership is a good concept. Treat all equipment as if you owned it and needed it to survive after a plane crash in the desert.

We are willing servants. Whatever you see to do, do it. Look for things that aren't done and for children who need special care. Be a servant.

Never invade a child's private space. Wave and talk to children allowing them to approach you. Costumed characters and clowns can scare children if they approach too quickly.

Our host families deserve our respect. Do all you can to protect the property and integrity of the host family. Clean up any mess left at the end of the service. Be polite. Say thank you!

Witness to anyone who will listen. We are primarily reaching children, but the opportunity arises each year to witness to youth and even adults through N.O.W. meetings. Be sensitive to God and share his good news with all.

## **Team Schedule for N.O.W. Side Yard Parties**

### **Morning**

- 8:00 am Team members meet at the church to pray and load vans.
- 8:30 am Teams leave church parking lot for N.O.W. host homes.
- 9:00 am Team unloads at host home, sets up, and passes out flyers.
- 10:00 am Side Yard Party program begins.
- 10:43 am Side Yard Party program concludes.
- 10:45 am Refreshments are served and team loads van.
- 11:00 am Team thanks host and head back to church.
- 11:30 am Teams meet back at church, testify, and disperse until tomorrow.

(Optional victory luncheon may be served each day.)

### **Evening**

- 5:30 PM Team members meet at the church to pray and load vans.
- 6:00 PM Teams leave church parking lot for N.O.W. host homes.
- 6:30 PM Team unloads at host home, sets up, and passes out flyers.
- 7:30 PM Side Yard Party program begins.
- 8:13 PM Side Yard Party program concludes.
- 8:15 PM Refreshments are served and team loads van.
- 8:30 PM Team thanks host and head back to church.
- 9:00 PM Teams meet back at church, testify, and disperse until tomorrow.

## **RULES FOR CLOWNS AND COSTUME CHARACTERS**

**DO** Show an interest in every child. You are here to serve children. Look for children who are wanting to interact with you.

**DON'T** show favoritism at the expense of other children. From time to time there will be one child who wants to monopolize a character's time. You may sit by or spend time with a child who needs special attention, but be aware of other children around you and do all you can to make every child feel special.

**DO** dance and make huge gestures to the music.

**DON'T** dance and make huge gestures in the crowd. You may step on a child and hurt him.

**DO** greet and meet each child before the program.

**DON'T** scare children by invading their private space. Do all you can to invite the child to come to you. Do not rush up to a small child. Your sudden appearance close to a child may scare that child out of loving clowns and costumed characters forever.

**DO** listen to, and follow the directions of your team leader.

**DON'T** follow directions to an extreme, thereby frustrating your team leader or fellow members.

**DO** look for fun ways to improve the program.

**DON'T** experiment with these during the program. Always talk with your team leader before implementing a new idea in a program. Most ideas are great and will be used. Once and a while an idea may be inappropriate for the age level or the event. Your team leader can help you determine if an idea is usable at N.O.W. meetings.

**DO** wear the costume the entire time you are serving the children in a particular neighborhood.

**DON'T** take off a costume character during a program or while neighborhood children can see you. Kids love to believe these costumes and clowns are real. Ripping off your costume head or clown nose in front of the child ruins an otherwise harmless illusion and may scare a child.

**DO** walk the neighborhoods handing out flyers. Be friendly and courteous to everyone you meet.

**DON'T** walk alone. A costume or clown character must always be accompanied by a real person. This person protects the character and helps with any non-pretend difficulties that may arise. This is an outdoor ministry. Do not enter neighborhood homes without the approval of your team leader.

**DO** enjoy yourself in this ministry. The joy of the Lord is your strength.

**DON'T** go slap happy nuts in the presence of children or neighborhood adults.

## **A Note To Our Neighborhood Outreach Week Hosts**

N.O.W. Side Yard Parties June 21-25, 1999

Greetings in the Name of Jesus!

I am so excited about our upcoming Neighborhood Outreach Week. You can see from the list of N.O.W. Side Yard Party locations that we are going to have an incredible impact in our communities. Last year our Side Yard Parties averaged 43 in attendance. If that holds true this time, we could reach over 1200 people through this ministry.

Let me take this moment to thank you for allowing a N.O.W. team to invade your yard and impact your neighborhood. Your hosting begins during your Side Yard Party, and continues as neighbors begin to turn to you in time of need. You will become, through your Side Yard Party, a lighthouse in a darkened world.

I have enclosed with this note, a complete listing of N.O.W. Side Yard Party locations so that you may pray each day for this outreach. On Sundays, June 6, 13 & 21, a N.O.W. Side Yard Party table will be set up in the church atrium. Flyers for your specific meeting can be picked up at this table. Please map out directions to your home and turn them in at the N.O.W. Side Yard Party table. These directions will be used by your Side Yard Party team captain in finding your home.

Most of our Side Yard Parties are being held in the mornings. The team will arrive at 9:00 a.m. to set up in your yard and pass out additional flyers. The N.O.W. Side Yard Party will begin at 10:00 a.m. and run about 40 minutes in length. Prizes will be given and the team will leave your yard around 11:00 a.m. The church will be providing refreshments to be served at the conclusion of the meeting. You may add to these, but this is not required.

If you are hosting an evening meeting, a team will arrive at your house at about 6:30 p.m. with the meeting beginning at 7:30 p.m. In the event that it rains, you will receive a call canceling the meeting. This is a one time shot. If a meeting is canceled due to weather, it will not be rescheduled. Pray for good weather that week.

**Theme: Jesus is the Way**

Side Yard Party leader opens.

**Welcome:**

Good morning everybody! I am so glad that you decided to come to this Side Yard Party today. We came to this yard in your neighborhood today so that you could have fun and learn about God. We are going to have puppets, and songs, and fun, and clowns, and stories, and fun, and learn about Jesus and have more fun. I know you are all going to enjoy this today. In order for everyone to enjoy the program we have two very easy rules you can follow.

**Rules:**

Our rules are so easy even you three year olds can follow them.

The first one is no walking. Our Side Yard Party is only about 39 minutes long and I know you want to hear and see everything. It's hard to see when someone is walking around so we want everyone to find a seat and relax and enjoy the show.

Our Second rule is no talk. No talk includes any kind of noise that would disturb the person next to you. I know you want to hear everything the puppets, clowns, and helpers say. No talk helps so that everyone can hear what is going on.

I know you can follow these two simple rules, No Walk, No Talk. We are going to pray and then I will tell you about our prize give-a-way.

**Prayer:**

It is so important to start with prayer. I start everything in my life with prayer. Why? Because wants to hear from his kids. He wants to hear from you. Let's close our eyes and pray right now.

"Jesus, thank you for this beautiful day. I pray that you will bless every boy and girl sitting hear and every mom or dad as well. Help us to have fun learning more about you. Bless all of our clowns and puppeteers and bless the people who live here cause they let us use their yard for Side Yard Party. Help us obey the simple rules, no walk and no talk. I pray this in Jesus name, Amen.

**Prize Give-A-Way**

Now let me tell you about our prize. I hope everyone here has filled out a Side Yard Party registration card at the sign-in table down by the driveway. All of those cards are going to be put in the bucket and in about 37 minutes, we will pick one name out of the bucket. That person will win our Super Soaker today. (We used Super Soakers for prizes this year. The big prize is dependent on what is donated in cash or prizes. You want it to be something nice enough to encourage all children to register. It must also be suitable for a boy or a girl.)

I hope my name is picked, don't you?

**Theme:**

Today, every skit and song and story will help us learn that Jesus is the only Way to heaven. The Bible says, "Jesus is the way, and the truth, and the life." People have invented all kinds of ways that they think will get others to heaven. But Jesus is the only way. Here to sing about this are our puppets.

**Puppet Song:**

Heavenly Streets (RPM, One Way Street Inc.)

Leader: The puppets have been asking if we can tell them how to get to heavenly streets. Well that is what we are talking about today. We can tell the puppets, and you how to get to heavenly streets. Jesus is the Way to those heavenly streets. One thing we will do in heaven is sing praises to God. Here is a simple song that everyone can sing. Our clowns are holding the words for those of you who know how to read.

At times during the song, I will raise my right hand and point to the sky. When I do that, everyone shout, "Wooo!" As the music begins, let's practice. (Have the kids shout woo a couple of times. This gets every child following your directions and working together.)

**Song:**

Sing Shout! Integrity Music, Sing A Long Praise Album

Leader: You all did a super job singing that song. Because we know that Jesus is the only way to heaven, we can sing songs like that every day, not just on Sundays. We have a helper now who is coming to teach us a very easy to learn, Bible verse. She will be assisted by our costumed character, Clint Apewood. (Clint is a full bodied costume character)

**Scripture:**

Jesus said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life." John 14:6a

Worker: Hi, kids. I'm going to let our costumed friend, Clint Apewood hold this poster board with today's Scripture picture on it. You heard me right, I said, Scripture picture. We have drawn today's Bible verse in picture form so that even the little guys who can't read words will understand what it says.

The Verse reads, "Jesus said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life." John 14:6a Let us all say that together a couple of times. (repeat the verse several times) Now I wonder if there is anyone here who can say the verse if Clint hides it behind his back? (Choose a child or two to try it and then have everyone repeat it one last time.) Didn't those kids do well, Clint? Of course they did. Remember, kids Jesus said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life." He is the only Way to heaven.

Leader: Thank you so much for helping us with the Bible verse today. Right now, our clowns are going to present a little skit called, "Jesus is the Way."

**Clown Skit:**

"Jesus is the Way!"

A Clown Skit by Dick Gruber

Clown 1 enters stage right carrying a large unfolded map. Written in huge black letters across the map are the words, "GOD'S WAY." The clown is walking, obviously trying to read and follow the map. He stops at center stage and reads.

Another clown enters from the left carrying a foam-core sign with the word "LIES" written on it. He tries to convince clown 1 to go his way. Clown 1 thinks about it, checks with his map and points to the words, GOD'S WAY shaking his head no to Clown 2.

Clown 2 exits only to be replaced by Clown 3 who carries a foam-core sign which reads "DISOBEY." Again, clown 1 is tempted but refuses while pointing from the map to the sky as if to say, I will go God's way. Clown 3 exits.

Clowns 2 & 3 enter with foam-core signs listing many sins around the large words, "MY WAY." They try to convince clown one to give up the map, but he refuses.

Clowns 2 & 3 walk off to the right and Clown A begins walking to the left. He stops, checks his map, tips his hat to God and exits as an off stage voice says, "There is a way that seems right to man, but the end of that way is destruction, Jesus is the only way to heaven."

Leader: That's so good, kids. Jesus is the only way to heaven. Thank you clowns. There are many ways that people have come up with. They think that these will get you to heaven, but Jesus is the only Way. Now our Bible Story Lady, Miss Darlene, is coming to help us with a true story from the Bible, God's Word.

**Bible Story:****Prodigal Son**

(We have purchased flip chart stories from Bill Hovey Audio Visual Company in Minneapolis, Minnesota. The artwork is fresh and fun. We color it in and laminate the pages. The Bible story comes with an explanation for each picture. With practice, this is very effective in a yard.)

Leader: That was a great Bible story. When one boy or girl accepts the truth that Jesus is the way, the angels in heaven have a party. Each one of us is like the runaway son in the story. We try going our own way. All of the time, God, like a good father, is waiting for us to go his way, to come home to him. When you accept Jesus as your way, Father God welcomes you into the family just like the dad in the story welcomed his lost son. Our puppets have another song for you right now.

**Puppet Song:**

Jesus Is The Way - This song is taken off of a Carman CD. He sings with children singing in the background. It is very nice for puppets.

Leader: All morning we have been talking and singing that Jesus is the way. Our clowns are coming to

help us learn more about this. I hear their music so here they are, the clowns.

**Clown Skit:**

I Know The Way

A Clown Skit by Dick Gruber

(Clown 1 enters stage right. He is carrying a suitcase that has a label saying, "Heavnbound.")

Clown 1: I know the way! (He laughs like it is a big secret.) I know the way to ... (he looks around as if to speak so nobody will hear) ... HEAVEN! I have it all in this suitcase.

(Clown 2 enters and notices that Clown 1 is acting suspicious.)

Clown 2: What are you doing?

Clown 1: Oh Nothing. (he tries to stop laughing but can't)

Clown 2: I know you are up to something. So tell me what it is.

Clown 1: OK. I know the way.

Clown 2: The way to where?

Clown 1: To heaven. I know the way to heaven, and I have it right here in my suitcase.

Clown 2: That's ridiculous. The way to heaven can't be in there.

Clown 1: It sure is. I'll show you. (He opens the case and pulls out a super soaker. He squirts a few blasts into the audience.) See, Jesus is the living water and I have water so I'm going to heaven.

Clown 2: Jesus is the way all right, but owning a super soaker doesn't mean you are going to heaven.

Clown 1: Oh, I didn't know that. Well look at this. (he pulls out a ball and glove.) I can play baseball. Anyone who can play baseball must be going to heaven.

Clown 2: Wrong again. Jesus is the only way to heaven. Being good at sports may help you on planet earth, but it won't get you to heaven.

Clown 1: Well... OK. But this will do it for sure. ( He pulls out a trash bag.) I help my neighbors by picking up trash all over the neighbor hood. I do lots of other things to help like, I fix my baby brother lunch and he wipes it in his hair, and I did laundry once but all of our clothes shrunk and our underwear turned pink. And then I...

Clown 2: STOP! Doing good things will never get you to heaven. Jesus is the only way!

Clown 1: I see now. I don't need this old suit case. I just need Jesus.

Clown 2: That's right! Jesus is the way!

Clown 1: I know the way. (Laughs again) The way to heaven is Jesus. (They both walk off.)

Leader: You can know the way, just like our clown does. You can't earn your way to heaven, or pay your way, or work your way. Why? Because, Jesus is the way! In a few minutes, I am going to draw a name to win our prize, but first, I have something to show you, we will pray, and the puppets will present one last song.

**Sermon:**

Wordless Bag or Book - This and old Child Evangelism Fellowship device that is wonderful for explaining salvation in a simple way for children. You can read about it and see an example in the Children's Ministries Bible. (Also Available through One Way Street inc.)

There are five basic colors which you can be shown on a chart, umbrella, poster boards, cloth bag, flip charts, or even a neck tie on one of your clowns. The colors are black, red, white, green, gold.

Black:

This dark page represents the darkness of sin. We all want to go to heaven, but the darkness of sin keeps us out. The Bible says, "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

Sin is the wrong that we do. Disobeying, lying, cheating, stealing, disrespecting mom or dad are all sins. Have you ever been out on a dark, dark night? Maybe there are clouds overhead blocking out the light of the moon and stars. This is like the darkness of sin. Sin, the wrong we do, makes it hard for us to see the way. We need a light. Jesus is the light that shines through sin making a way for us to go to heaven.

Red:

This color represents the blood which Jesus shed for our sin. He died on the cross to make a way for you and me. I know that many of you boys and girls have seen programs at Christmas or Easter time which show Jesus being born or dying on a cross. These are true stories. Jesus really did come to this earth, live like us, and die on a cross for the forgiveness of our sin. In Scripture it says, though your sin be as scarlet, (red), it shall be whiter than snow." Jesus made a way for our sin to be forgiven by dying on the cross for us.

White:

This clean white card shows us that when we ask Jesus to forgive our sin, He is faithful and just and will forgive our sin and clean us from all wrong or unrighteousness.

Jesus is in the business of washing hearts. No, not your blood pumper, but that part of you which is dirtied by the darkness of sin. He cleans us from the inside out. When we accept his love, and ask him to forgive our sin, the way to heaven is opened before us.

Green:

The green represents the new life we have in Jesus. Jesus doesn't just make a way to forgive our sin, but He also gives us a new life. The Bible says, "if any man is in Christ, he is a new creation, the old has passed away, behold, all things have become new. Jesus wants to give each of us a brand new abundant life in Him.

Gold:

Finally the gold represents heaven. We all want to go there some day. Jesus is the only way. He stands at the door to your life today and knocks. I know many of you want to let Him in. He made a way for you to have your sin forgiven, walk in newness of life, and go to those heavenly streets.

Like the runaway son in our story today, you can come home to Jesus right now. Let's all pray together. Repeat after me.

**Dear Jesus,**

**I have sinned. I have done wrong. I have disobeyed. I am sorry. Please forgive me. Wash away my sin. I know you are the only way. You died on the cross for me. Please give me a new life right now. I believe in you, Jesus. Thank you.**

By raising your hand, show me how many of you prayed that for the first time? The angels in heaven are having a party right now because of you. Jesus is your way to forgiveness, life, and heaven. Our puppets have one more song.

**Puppet Song:**

The Broad Way: This song is found on a One Way Street Inc. tape entitled, God's Way.

**Conclusion:**

Leader: You all did an awesome job today, obeying our simple rules. Thank you for coming to our Side Yard Party. Well it is time to draw a name for our prize. Remember, only one person can win the super soaker, but all of you are winners if you learned our verse, "Jesus said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life." John 14:6a

Jesus is looking, or seeking, to save every boy and girl, every big person from the hurt that sin brings.

Leader: Thank you so much for helping us with the Bible verse today. Right now, our clowns are going to present a little skit called, "Jesus is the Way."

**Clown Skit:**

TITLE: The Lost Teddy Bear

Characters: One key clown & two -six others

Props needed: A Teddy Bear for each clown

Preparation: Each clown waits stage left while holding a Teddy Bear. The key clown gives his bear,

with instruction, to a child in the crowd before the service.

**ACTION:** All clowns enter to center stage. Each one is admiring their own and then the other Teddy bears. The key clown begins looking for his bear. Others ignore him while continuing to compliment and admire bears. Key clown, in frustration yells, "Hello people! Listen a minute!" All clowns straighten up themselves and their bears.

**Key Clown:** I have lost my bear. He is gone. This is a bear I love. Sure I have 99 other bears at home, but it is important that we find my bear. Every little bear is important to me. You look up here and I shall search the neighborhood."

Clowns begin looking at each other's feet, behind puppet stage, and around kids in front row. Key clown finds his bear and with dancing and singing, rejoices with the other clowns. He then stops and reminds the crowd, "There is more rejoicing in heaven over one boy or girl who decides to live for God."

**Leader:** That's so true, kids. Thank you clowns. The angels in heaven rejoice each time a boy or girl is found. Now our Bible Story Lady, Miss Darlene is coming to help us with a true story from the Bible, God's Word.

**Bible Story:**

The Lost Sheep - A Worker tells the story while another flips the pictures. The Bible story comes with an explanation for each picture. With practice, this is very effective in a yard.

**Leader:** That was a great Bible story. When one boy or girl accepts the truth that Jesus is looking for him, and says yes to God's love, the angels in heaven have a party. Each one of us is like the lost sheep in the story. We try going our own way. All of the time, God, like a good father, is looking for us. He wants to forgive us and save us from the hurt that sin brings. When you accept Jesus as your friend, Father God welcomes you into His family. Our puppets have another song for you right now.

**Puppet Song:** Love your Neighbor (Veggie Tunes)

**Leader:** Once you are found by Jesus, Loving your neighbor is so much easier. Our clowns are coming to help us learn more about trusting and being found by Jesus. I hear their music so here they are, the clowns.

**Clown Skit:**

**TITLE:** The Chair

**Characters:** 3-6 clowns

**Props needed:** A chair

**Preparation:** Clowns stand stage right while one clown enters and sets up the chair center stage and announces, "The Chair, a lesson on believing."

**ACTION:** Each clown enters, looks at chair, thinks about sitting in it, announces that he will soon do this, but decides not to sit in the chair. Here are some reasons given: Legs may break. Wet paint. Not strong enough. Could be a trap. What if it is a doorway into an alternate universe and aliens there don't

eat peanut butter?

Each one of us is like the beat up and robbed guy in the story. We need a good Samaritan to help. Jesus is that good Samaritan. He loves us so much that he died on a cross to save us from our sin. He wants to forgive us and save us from the hurt that sin brings. When you accept Jesus' love, Father God welcomes you into His family. Our puppets have another song for you right now.

### **Puppet Song:**

God's Love, One Way Street Inc.

## **Clown Skit:**

TITLE: You First

Characters: All Clowns

Props needed: airplane, ball, bucket

Preparation: Clowns stand stage right while one clown enters. He looks around and says, "What a beautiful day!"

**ACTION:** Other clowns enter two at a time with the props. The two stop as they get close to the lead clown. The two are sort of arguing. "You first." "No, No, No, I insist, you go first." No, I just can't. If I go first, I may break a nail, or stub my little toe. You go first." (Other reasons can be add-libbed.) Each twosome, is then interrupted by the lead clown who asks permission to see the prop and then uses it properly. The two other clowns are amazed that he could do it. They pick up the prop and as they exit, use it properly as well while talking about how he had the nerve to go first. After three props have been used, the lead clown stops, looks at the audience and says, "God went first when he showed us his love. It's our turn now."

**Leader:** You can take a turn at loving God today. You can believe in Jesus just like our clown does. God has been going first for a long time. He has loved you all of your life. He wants to forgive and to save you. He wants to be your friend. Just ask him today!

God's love changes us. (change bag, dirty silk, clean silk)

I want to show you that God's love can change you. What I am about to do, any one here could do. You can read about it at the library.
